# 1. IMPORTANT ELECTION SCHEDULE DATES:

- A. SEPTEMBER 1ST-Solicitation for candidates will be distributed to all club members.
- B. SEPTEMBER 15TH -Due date for all "Submission of Interest" Forms from all prospective candidates.
  - C. SEPTEMBER 30TH-OCTOBER 13TH- Voting period
- D. OCTOBER 14,15TH OR 16TH- Tabulation of ballots by the Election Committee
- E. OCTOBER 17TH-Announcement of election results at the Gala Event.

## 2. **ELECTION PROCESS:**

- A. Vote will be conducted via an anonymous paper ballot to be inserted by each club member in an envelope labeled with each club member's name.
- B. Ballot envelopes shall be placed in the club mailbox in the clubhouse.
- C. On the date the election is concluded, ballot envelopes will be opened by the election committee.
- D. After all ballots are opened, and placed in an election box, they will be tabulated by the committee
- E. THE ELECTION COMMITTEE will consist of the past president, and two to three members at large. No candidate running may sit on the committee.

### 3. **BOARD POSITIONS:**

A. PRESIDENT: Connects with and represents all members of the club. Works collaboratively with all board members to ensure the club's vision is being carried out. Oversees that each board position is being done effectively and with integrity. Available to support board members as needed. Creates the agenda for the weekly board meetings and runs the meetings. Direct liaison to the HOA representing the interests of the pickleball club. Responsible for overseeing the election committee and the process.

- B. TREASURER: Safeguard assets, maintain books and records (currently Quickbooks), file annual report and tax return with appropriate government agency, accounts payable, develop annual budget, reconcile membership registration with "Membership" board member's records, reconcile paid event registrations with the "Social Event's" board member's records, distribute financial reports periodically to membership.
- C. SECRETARY: Responsible for taking the minutes at every board meeting, presenting the minutes for the board's approval, revising as needed, and finally archiving and making available for the membership. The Secretary oversees the writing and revision of the Club By-laws, and monitors that the By-Laws are being adhered to by all members of the club.
- D. MEMBERSHIP: Considered an ambassador to the club. Meeting and reaching out to new members. Obtains application and payment for club membership dues. Responsible for keeping accurate and updated spreadsheet with all individual member information. Works in partnership with the Treasurer confirming membership and payment status, thus ensuring membership numbers and dues monies are aligned. Monitors and crosschecks TeamReach and RMPC Website to make sure all members have joined these two social media networks. Takes attendance at club events. Contacts members as needed asking or responding to concerns and questions.
- E. COMMUNICATION: Responsible for writing all club related articles that appear in all Regency Publications, including the Regency Reporter. Works directly with Court Programming and Social Events to create the flyers promoting all competitive and social activities, as well as collaborating and collecting all key information when following-up and writing on these events. Will assume responsibility for content development and postings on RMPC Website and TeamReach. Will oversee and coordinate with the Webmaster, a new sub-committee position, to assist with content updates on all social media sites.
- F. COURT PROGRAMMING: Plan, develop and implement all on court pickleball events. Creates and presents a calendar of events to the Pickleball Board and works collaboratively with the Social Event's Board Member to put forth a coordinated club calendar for the year. Oversees two different sub-committees: Competition Committee: (consisting of Leagues, Tournaments, Ladders, Round Robins) and the Clinics Committee (creating the clinics based on member needs, and identifying instructors best suited to present the clinic). Directly involved with all court initiatives, including "Open Play" and "Friday Night Lights". Will work with

the Webmaster on the monitoring and maintaining of the registration for all events, as well as coordinating the advertising of events on the club website and TeamReach.

G. SOCIAL EVENTS: Responsible for the planning of monthly social events. Works directly with HOA to ascertain and schedule dates for all social activities, as well as coordinates the needed items for the set-up for each event. Collaborates with Communication regarding the creation of all flyers for social events, and follows-up with Webmaster on all social media postings. Research, comparison shop, and purchase Develops and oversees the Social Events Sub-Committee, who assist in the set-up, delivery, and clean-up at club socials.

As a board member, the expectation is to be available to help one another as needed. As a board member, the inherent belief must be "For the Good of the Club". As a board member, it cannot be about one's own personal interests, but what is in the best interest of the club members. The reason for our club's success is the strength in the community we have built.
